In today's Gospel, Jesus teaches from Simon's boat and instructs him to lower the fishing nets. Simon protests at first but ultimately obeys Jesus and lowers his nets into the deeper water as directed. They catch so many fish that the nets begin to tear; Jesus' presence has created abundance out of scarcity, just as it did at the wedding feast at Cana, which we heard at Mass just a few weeks ago. Simon Peter calls Jesus "Lord and protests his worthiness to be in Jesus' presence. Peters task will be to bring others to Jesus. Already he is doing so; the Gospel tells us that all the fishermen with Peter also left their nets and followed Jesus.
