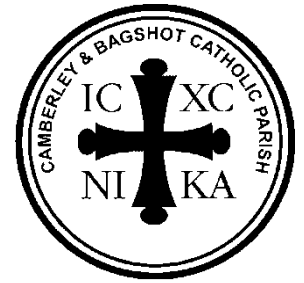

“There is a very human tendency to reduce the Christian Faith to some form of moral rigorism, or mere ethics. In previous generations our moral rigorism may have focussed on issues of sexual morality; in recent decades, the Gospel message has often been reduced to an amorphous and ubiquitous concern for social justice. In the end, however noble, these are all moral issues that need to be contextualised by the reception of the Good news of salvation. Moral issues are always and will always be secondary issues that can never supplant the ‘first proclamation’ of the Gospel, the *kerygma*, lest, as Pope Francis has said, the Church fall like a house of cards.”
