Ephesians 1:3-14 "Before the world was made God chose us"

Mark 6:7-13 "I will raise up shepherds to look after them."

In Mark's Gospel Jesus sent out the Twelve. These twelve were selected from among Jesus' disciples. Mark notes that these twelve are also called "apostles." which means "one who is sent." Jesus continues to send us into the world as his disciples. But like the first disciples, we are not sent alone. Jesus has given us the community of the Church, which strengthens our life of discipleship. The Christian message can only authentically be proclaimed in and through the community of faith that is the Church.
