Jeremiah 17:5-8 "A blessing on the man who puts his trust in the Lord"

Psalm; HAPPY THE MAN WHO HAS PLACED HIS TRUST IN THE LORD

1 Corinthians 15:12,16-20 "If Christ has not been raised, your believing is useless"

Luke 6:17,2-26 "How happy are you who are poor. Alas for you who are rich."

Today's gospel reading is the beginning of what is called the Sermon on the Plain. The parallel in is Matthew 5:1-7,11 that is known as the Sermon on the Mount. The Beatitudes of Luke's and Matthew's Gospel are not unique to Jesus. As we listen to this Gospel, the Beatitudes jar our sensibilities. Those who are poor, hungry, weeping, or persecuted are called blessed. This is, indeed, a Gospel of reversals. Those often thought to have been forgotten by God are called blessed. Our vocation is not to be first in this world, but rather to be first in the eyes of God. We are to focus on our ultimate horizon, the Kingdom of God.
