We continue to read from the sixth chapter of the Gospel of John. In last Sunday's gospel the crowds wondered how Jesus could say that he had come down from heaven. In this Gospel, some have difficulty with Jesus' teaching that he is the living bread sent from God. Jesus had told them that just as God gave the Israelites manna to sustain them in the desert, so now God has sent new manna that will give eternal life.: Jesus himself is the bread sent by God; Jesus' flesh is the bread that is given for the life of the world.
