Today is **Racial Justice Sunday**. As Catholics we are to treat all humans with dignity, regardless of their background or circumstance. There are many stories of alienation throughout the Bible, with clear calls to "Love the stranger". Deuteronomy 10:19 says that you should "Love the stranger then, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt." Or from Jeremiah 22:3 where you must "practice honesty and integrity; rescue the man who has been wronged from the hands of the oppressors; do not exploit the stranger, the orphan, the widow; do no violence; shed no innocent blood in this place. The New Testament takes this one stage further as personified in Jesus who summarises the Commandments in Mark 12:30-31 as "to love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength." ³¹ The second is this, 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
