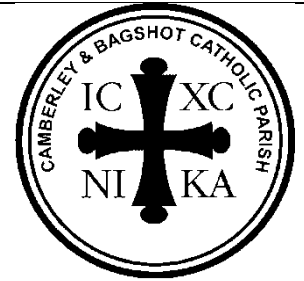

Last Thursday the Parish heard the 4<sup>th</sup> talk in the series by Catholic Voices, on the subject of 'The Reforms of Pope Francis – a Church Fit for Mission?' Our speaker Michele Acquisito outlined three areas that Pope Francis has sought to introduce reform; first the finances of the Vatican, arguing that for the Church's mission to be credible, the finances of the Holy See must be transparent; second, 'Clericalism,' in the sense of not identifying the Church with the clergy, but rather emphasising the role of the laity at the forefront of the Church's mission, helped by the clergy; third, 'Decentralisation,' to avoid a centre separated from the periphery by appointing Cardinals not all from Europe and granting Bishops Conferences the means to find local solutions to local problems, in order to serve the mission of the Church at the local level. The speaker outlined that 'progress' in the Church has never been via 'revolution' but always by 'reform,' and always with 'holiness' as the motivation for change. Michele reminded the audience of Pope Francis' definition of the Church – "a battlefield hospital tending to the wounded" and challenged those present to 'reform' their own lives so as to better serve the Church's mission – first, in their finances, second in their clericalism, third in their reaching out to those on the peripheries. The 5<sup>th</sup> and final talk in this series is entitled 'Being a Catholic Voice in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century'. All are welcome at St Tarcisius Hall 8pm – 9pm on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> April.
