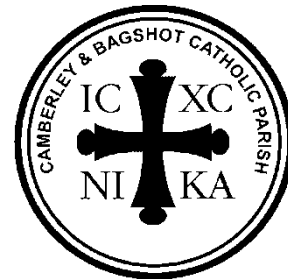

By tradition, November is the month in which we pray for the souls of our loved ones who have died. However, we are not to limit our prayers to those of our family and friends who have died. It is a catholic practice to pray for the Holy Souls.

Why do we pray for the dead? The Catholic Catechism teaches *"All who die in God's grace and friendship, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven."* (n 1030). It is our great privilege that we can assist the Holy Souls by our prayers, good works, and, especially, the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. This month we can write the names of our loved ones on a list of prayers and they will be brought to the altar so that our prayers are united with the offering of Christ.

While those whom the Church has deemed to be the canonized Saints are in Heaven and are, therefore, in no need of our prayers *for them*, we've always asked for them to pray *for us*. As to Holy Souls in Purgatory, St. Robert Bellarmine teaches that because they are so close to the Lord their prayers for us are very effective. So, as you pray *for your dead loved ones*, ask them to pray *for you*, too!

God our Father, Your power brings us to birth, Your providence guides our lives, and by Your command we return to dust. Lord, those who die still live in Your presence, their lives change but do not end. I pray in hope for my family, relatives and friends, and for all the dead known to You alone. In company with Christ, Who died and now lives, may they rejoice in Your kingdom, where all our tears are wiped away. Unite us together again in one family, to sing Your praise forever and ever. Amen.
