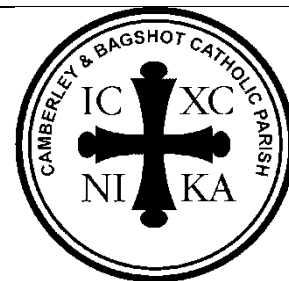

Last Thursday the Parish heard the last in the Lenten series of talks by the organisation Catholic Voices, to help Catholics 'defend the Faith without shouting.' This talk was given by Laura Thompson, a member of the Parish of Richmond, who spoke on the subject of 'Being a Catholic Voice in the 21st Century' - *who* can be a Catholic Voice, *how* to be a Catholic Voice and *why* we should be a Catholic Voice. *Who?* The audience was reminded that being a Catholic Voice is not the prerogative of the ordained or those in religious vows, but rather ordinary Catholics who live and work in the world; baptism is the only qualification for taking on this role; *How?* The speaker summarized the 'Reframing' methodology, in which the Catholic Voice seeks to identify the value which motivates someone's difficulty with Church teaching (i.e., a concern for 'equality') and then to 'reframe' the discussion to show that this value is also the basis of Catholic teaching, a methodology that requires prayer and study; *Why?* The speaker reminded those listening that we have 'Good News' to share with a world that needs to hear it. St Peter says "Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have." Let us pray that this series of talks by Catholic Voices in the Parish will bear much fruit, strengthening us to be a Catholic Voice, to live out the vocation that we have received in Baptism.
