

WE ENCOUNTER JESUS – WE GROW TOGETHER IN HIS LOVE

Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ

Growing together by being known, loved and supported

Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, Witness, and serve

Today's Gospel again comes from the Gospel of John (13:31-33a,34-35).when Jesus washes his disciples' feet. Immediately after, Jesus predicts his betrayal by Judas. Today's Gospel follows that prediction. It can be read as a continuing explanation of Jesus' act of washing his disciples' feet. It begins with the announcement that this is the moment when the Son of Man will be glorified. This theme continues throughout John's Passion. Jesus will be glorified in his death on the cross and in his Resurrection, and the disciples will glorify Jesus in the love they show.

John's Gospel does not present a sentimental view of love but one that is shown in service and sacrifice. Jesus tells the disciples that all will know that they are his disciples because of the love they show for one another. This description of the early Christian community will be repeated in the Acts of the Apostles: "See how they love one another." Christian love is the hallmark of Christianity. We see it lived in the witness of the martyrs. We see it in the example of the lives of the saints. We see it in the holy women and men who live and love daily, making small and large sacrifices for others.

In his address to the Cardinals Pope Leo XIV said

*"I would like us to renew our commitment to the path that the Church has been following for decades in the wake of the Second Vatican Council. Pope Francis has masterfully recalled its content in the apostolic exhortation Evangelii gaudium, from which I would like to highlight the return to the primacy of Christ in proclamation, the missionary conversion of the entire Christian community, growth in collegiality and synodality, attention to the *sensus fidei*, especially in its most authentic and inclusive forms, such as popular piety, loving care for the least, the rejected, and courageous and trusting dialogue with the contemporary world. Precisely because I feel called to continue in this vein, I thought of taking the name Leo XIV (who) with his historic encyclical Rerum novarum, addressed the social .. context of the first great industrial revolution, and today the Church offers everyone its heritage of social teaching to respond to another industrial revolution and the developments of artificial intelligence, which pose new challenges for the defence of human dignity, justice and work."*

Let us pray for the Holy Father that the Lord may strengthen him in his Petrine ministry!



The Establishment of a new parish of Woking & Surrey Heath

Last year, Bishop Richard Moth published a Diocesan Pastoral Plan: *'The Word Who is Life: The Call to Mission'*, which outlines proposed changes to the structure of our parishes. The biggest change is a transition away from deaneries to one large parish formed of existing church communities.

The current Deanery of Woking is set to become a new canonical parish which will include: Christ the King Bagshot, St Tarcisius, Camberley, St Peter and St John Camberley, Our Lady Queen of Heaven Frimley, St Hugh of Lincoln Knaphill, St Dunstan's Woking, and Our Lady Help of Christians West Byfleet. This grouping of churches will be constituted under the proposed name of *"The Catholic Churches of Woking & Surrey Heath"* with the proposed mission statement **Mission Statement;**

"We are a family of churches that welcome everyone and work together in in Christ to build a strong community of Catholic faithful, who are rooted in prayer and empowered by the Holy Spirit, so that we can live out God's call to proclaim the Good News to all, today and tomorrow."

"There will be two consultation meetings to explain more about the proposed changes with the opportunity for questions. These are taking place at St Dunstan's Church in Woking on Tuesday 3rd on Tuesday 3rd June 7.30pm and Our Lady Queen of Heaven Church Frimley on Thursday 5th June 7.30pm."
