The liturgy for the 22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C brings us a strong message about humility. Jesus reminds us not to seek praise or high places. Instead, he shows us that real honour comes when we let go of pride. Those who lift themselves up will be brought down, but those who stay low will be raised up by God.

The readings today all point to the same idea. Sirach tells us to be gentle and humble. Hebrews reminds us that we are part of something bigger than we can see. And in the Gospel, Jesus teaches that when we welcome the poor, the sick, and the outcast, we welcome blessings that will last forever.

We are being asked; are we looking to impress others? Or are we quietly doing good and trusting God to see it? When we stop trying to get ahead, we make room for God to lead us. This is a Sunday to remember that the low place is not a punishment. It is a place where God meets us, where grace grows, and where real joy begins.


