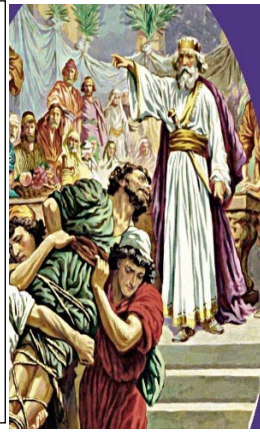

Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ

Growing together by being known, loved and supported.

Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, witness, and serve.

The readings for the 28th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A tell of the abundance of the Kingdom of God. In the first reading we hear of the wonders of the mountain of the Lord. The psalm tells of how God will care for us as a shepherd cares for his sheep. The second reading speaks of how God provides for us in abundance. And in the gospel Jesus compares the Kingdom of Heaven to a lavish wedding banquet.

The homily at Mass this Sunday will be on the theme of the “**best of leadership**”. The Divine Renovation Network says on its website divinerenovation.org “*When parish leaders serve out of the best leadership principles, parishes thrive One of the keys to parish renewal that we’ve uncovered through our work at Divine Renovation is the best of leadership principles. Leaders need people to lead and lift up.*”

A parish priest provides the best leadership when he leads from within a team. In our parish Fr Paul does this with the SLT that meets weekly to discuss organisation and communication, the Mission team that meets monthly to discuss ideas for mission, the Liturgy team the co-ordinates our main public worship and the Finance committee who are stewards of our finances and buildings. However, leadership is also shown by those who help others to share or take on their ministry and service. Our parish mission says that we are about “making disciples” It is disciples who make other disciples by exercising leadership in ministry and service in our parish

To be a leader, you must understand yourself first, so in prayer, ask God what your gifts and strengths are. Let us pray that gifts of our leadership teams and parishioners together, enable our parish to be a community of worship witness and service where disciples are made, and people are known love and supported.

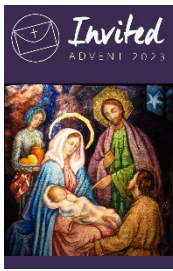

St Tarcisius Church Centenary In 1906, Fr Patrick Twomey came to Camberley and started to plan to build a new permanent church. On 12 September 1923, the foundation stone of the church was laid by the Bishop of Southwark, Peter Amigo. On 18 November 1924, the church was opened. The church was designed by Frederick Walters as a War Memorial for fallen British Catholic military officers in the First World War. It served as the chaplaincy for Catholics at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst.

We are planning to celebrate the centenary with a summer social event, a display of the history of the Church and a Mass celebrated by Bishop Richard Moth on Friday 17th November (7.30pm).

Fr Paul will be holding a meeting in St Tarcisius Hall on **Wednesday 18th October 7.30pm** to discuss the plans for the centenary. All are welcome
