**Mothering Sunday** is on the fourth Sunday of Lent. Traditionally, it was a day when children, mainly daughters, who had gone to work as domestic servants were given a day off to visit their mother and family. Centuries ago it was considered important for people to return to their home or 'mother' church once a year. So each year in the middle of Lent, everyone would visit their 'mother' church - the main church or cathedral of the area.

Inevitably the return to the 'mother' church became an occasion for family reunions when children who were working away returned home. It was quite common in those days for children to leave home for work once they were ten years old. And most historians think that it was the return to the 'Mother' church which led to the tradition of children, particularly those working as domestic servants, or as apprentices, being given the day off to visit their mother and family.

As they walked along the country lanes, children would pick wildflowers or violets to take to church or give to their mother as a small gift.

In scripture the image of a mother speaks of Gods providence for His children;

- **Isaiah 49:15:** "Can a mother forget her nursing child? Can she feel no love for the child she has borne?"
- **Proverbs 31:26:** "She opens her mouth with wisdom, and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue."
- **Proverbs 31:31:** "Honor her for all that her hands have done, and let her works bring her praise at the city gate."
- **Psalm 139:13-14:** "For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well."
