This Sunday we celebrate **Mass with the Anointing of the Sick** 3pm at Ss Peter & John Church. In the Church's Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick, through the ministry of the priest, it is Jesus who touches the sick to heal them from sin – and sometimes even from physical ailment. His cures were signs of the arrival of the Kingdom of God. The core message of his healing tells us of his plan to conquer sin and death by his dying and rising. When the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is given, the hoped-for effect is that, if it be God's will, the person be physically healed of illness. But even if there is no physical healing, the primary effect of the Sacrament is a spiritual healing by which the sick person receives the Holy Spirit's gift of peace and courage to deal with the difficulties that accompany serious illness or the frailty of old age

We celebrate the Mass of the Sick on the Sunday before the **Arundel and Brighton Pilgrimage to Lourdes** (25th to 31st July) in which hundreds of people from our diocese travel to the shrine of Our Lady. At the heart of the pilgrimage are the those who suffer from illness and disability. They participate fully in the pilgrim events and they will receive the sacrament of sick at a mass celebrated by Bishop Richard Moth.

He writes *“Lourdes is a place of renewal, a place where our relationship with Christ is deepened. Making the journey means entering a space in which we can be open to the promptings of the Holy Spirit in ways that, perhaps, we would never have thought possible before. The pilgrimage is a time of blessing for pilgrims, especially the sick and frail, for our Diocese and – because the power of prayer knows no bounds – for the wider world.”*

Our pilgrimage to Lourdes is one of the most significant pastoral events in our diocesan calendar each year. Pilgrims travel in response to the call of Our Blessed Mother to St Bernadette, coming to the Shrine to wash in the waters of the spring and to pray.”
