

WE ENCOUNTER JESUS - WE GROW TOGETHER IN HIS LOVE

Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ Growing together by being known, loved and supported Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, Witness, and serve

The scripture readings for the 21st Sunday in ordinary time proclaims that God gathers people from all corners of the earth. The message is clear. God's love is not limited to one group. He wants all people to come to Him. However, we are also reminded that following God is not always easy. In the Gospel, Jesus speaks about the narrow gate. He says that many will try to enter, but not all will succeed. Enter through the narrow gate requires humility and effort, recognizing that salvation is not automatic but involves our cooperation. In Hebrews, we learn that God disciplines those He loves, like a parent guides a child. This discipline helps us grow in righteousness and peace.

Our Lord does use "shocking" images to refocus our attentions on to his grace and mercy. We are not to be discouraged because we are being invited to keep walking with God, even when the road is hard. Entering the "narrow gate" means that we listen to one who is the "good shepherd" who leads us sheep through the gate. Only when we are attentive to His voice will we know where He is leading us. Only then will we discover the way through the one and only narrow gate.

Let us reflect on the joy of meeting Jesus the "Good Shepherd". What will that encounter be like? Will it be one where He greets you with open arms saying, "Well done, good and faithful servant, enter into your reward." Or will it be one in which He says, "I do not know you." Now is the time to face your life of faith with honesty, striving to rely only upon the strength of our divine Lord. God is calling all people to come and share in His joy. Let us respond with open hearts and ready hands.

Lord, I do desire to enter the narrow gate. I choose to follow Your gentle voice, leading me to Heaven. Help me to remain humble in life, shedding all that leads me to rely upon myself. May I rely only upon You, dear Lord, and trust You in all things. Jesus, I trust in You.
