WE ENCOUNTER JESUS - WE GROW TOGETHER IN HIS LOVE Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ Growing together by being known, loved and supported Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, witness, and serve

Today's Gospel reading (Luke 13:1-9) features the parable of the barren fig tree. When told to cut down the fig tree because it is not producing fruit, the gardener counsels patience. If properly tended, the barren fig tree may yet bear fruit. Throughout his journey to Jerusalem, Jesus has been teaching about the Kingdom of God. In this parable, we find an image of God's patience and hopefulness as he prepares his Kingdom. God calls us to repent, and it is within his power to punish us for our failure to turn from our sinfulness. And yet God is merciful. He delays punishment and tends to us so that we may yet bear the fruit he desires from us.

The parable of the fig tree in Luke highlights God's patience. He gives us time to change and grow in faith, but we must respond. This, then, is our reason for hope: Not only does God refuse to abandon us, he chooses to attend to us even when we show no evidence of his efforts. The psalm of todays mass speaks of God's goodness and mercy. This psalm praises God for His forgiveness, presence, and renewal in our lives. It acknowledges His justice and mercy, reminding us that He calls us back when we stray. Despite knowing our weaknesses and failures, God loves us deeply and offers us freedom. *"The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and rich in mercy. For as the heavens are high above the earth, so strong his mercy for those who fear him"* As the Lord is compassion and love may we be so towards others.

"Loving God, You have commanded us to show mercy and compassion to one another. I come to You for help because I believe You always provide what we need to accomplish Your will, and also, I know I lack what I need. With so much at stake in this lost and hurting world, Lord, I pray that You please give me a heart that is compassionate and merciful towards others. Amen."
