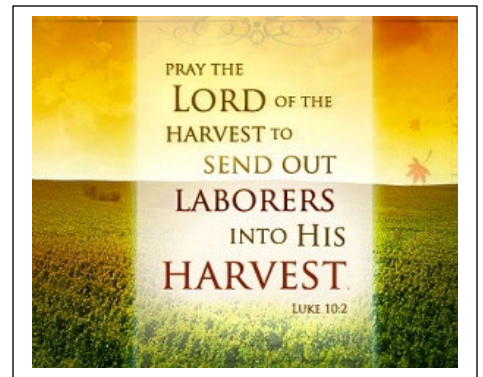

## WE ENCOUNTER JESUS - WE GROW TOGETHER IN HIS LOVE

Making disciples who encounter the saving love of Jesus Christ

Growing together by being known, loved and supported.

Empowered by the Holy Spirit to worship, witness, and serve

In this Sunday Gospel (**Luke 10:1-12,17-20**) Jesus appoints 72 people to go ahead of him to every town and place he plans to visit, proclaiming that the Kingdom of God is at hand. Jesus admits it will be difficult, that he is sending them out like lambs among wolves. Yet they are to bring nothing with them, not even a money bag or sandals. They are to greet no one on the way so as not to be distracted from their mission. When they enter a house, their message is simply “peace.” They are to heal the sick as a sign that the Kingdom of God is at hand for them. Like Jesus' miracles, healing is a sign of the coming of the kingdom.

A key theme of today's Gospel and last Sunday's Gospel is discipleship—its challenges, its difficulties, and its rewards. Sharing in the mission of Jesus is difficult, but everyone is called to do it, not just some professionals trained for ministry. Even for us today, the harvest is plentiful. We should pray to the master of the harvest to send out workers for his harvest.

We are grateful to the Lord for the **ordination to the priesthood**, for our diocese, of **Rev Nick Marden**. His ordination is taking place this Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at Arundel Cathedral. Please pray for him and for Eddie Hopkins, Gary Carter, Scott Coleman, Gustavo Campanello & Barnabas Mercer who are in formation to the priesthood for our diocese.

*O Lord, my God, You renew the Church in every age by raising up priests outstanding in holiness, living witnesses of Your unchanging Love. In Your Plan for our salvation You provide shepherds for Your people. Fill the hearts of young men with the spirit of courage and love that they may answer Your call generously. Give parents the grace to encourage vocations in their family by prayer and good example. Raise up worthy priests for Your Altars and ardent, but gentle servants of the Gospel. Give the Church more priests and keep them faithful in their love and service. May many young men choose to serve You by devoting themselves to the service of Your people.*

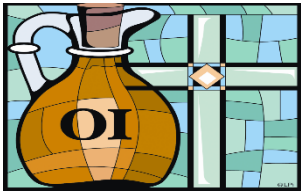

**On Monday 4 July a petition organised by Dignity in Dying, a pressure group who want to see the law changed to allow assisted suicide, will be debated at Westminster Hall.** The Catholic Church is against Assisted Dying, teaching that life is a gift to be cared for and preserved until natural death.
