### ***Preparing your child for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion***

The preparation for their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion is a very important time for your children. Parents are the main teachers of the faith to their children, and you will be supported by the parish catechists in using a programme called, 'Growing up Catholic.' The programme is open to children in Year 3 and above. At the end of the course your child will make his or her first Holy Communion in the church at which you worship.

Before registering your child for this course, please do be aware that there is a certain commitment of time involved and it is an essential part of the course that you and your child/ren are present at every session. The preparation for First Holy Communion and Reconciliation begins in December and a timetable of dates & times is provided.

I will be running a **Parent's session** in November using the Sycamore Course (Who is Jesus & the Power of Prayer) It is a great way to help parents in their faith and the religious upbringing of their children. There will be two sessions one on **Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> November** 11.00am to 12.30pm and one on **Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> November** 7.30pm to 9.00pm both will be at Ss Peter and John Church Hall. Parents must attend **one** of the **two sessions** if they wish to enrol their child in the First Communion course.
